- V. Kingdom advancement in Asia Minor required changing who was accepted in the church (12:25-16:5).
- VI. Kingdom advancement in Europe and in the Aegean area required changing minds to new horizons (16:6-19:20).
- VII. Kingdom advancement in Rome required God's intervention (19:21-28:31).
